- IV. ASRIC Journal on Health Sciences

These have been combined into a single publication with the name titled ASRIC SCIENTIFIC JOURNALS.

The ASRIC SCIENTIFIC JOURNALS will be annual publication

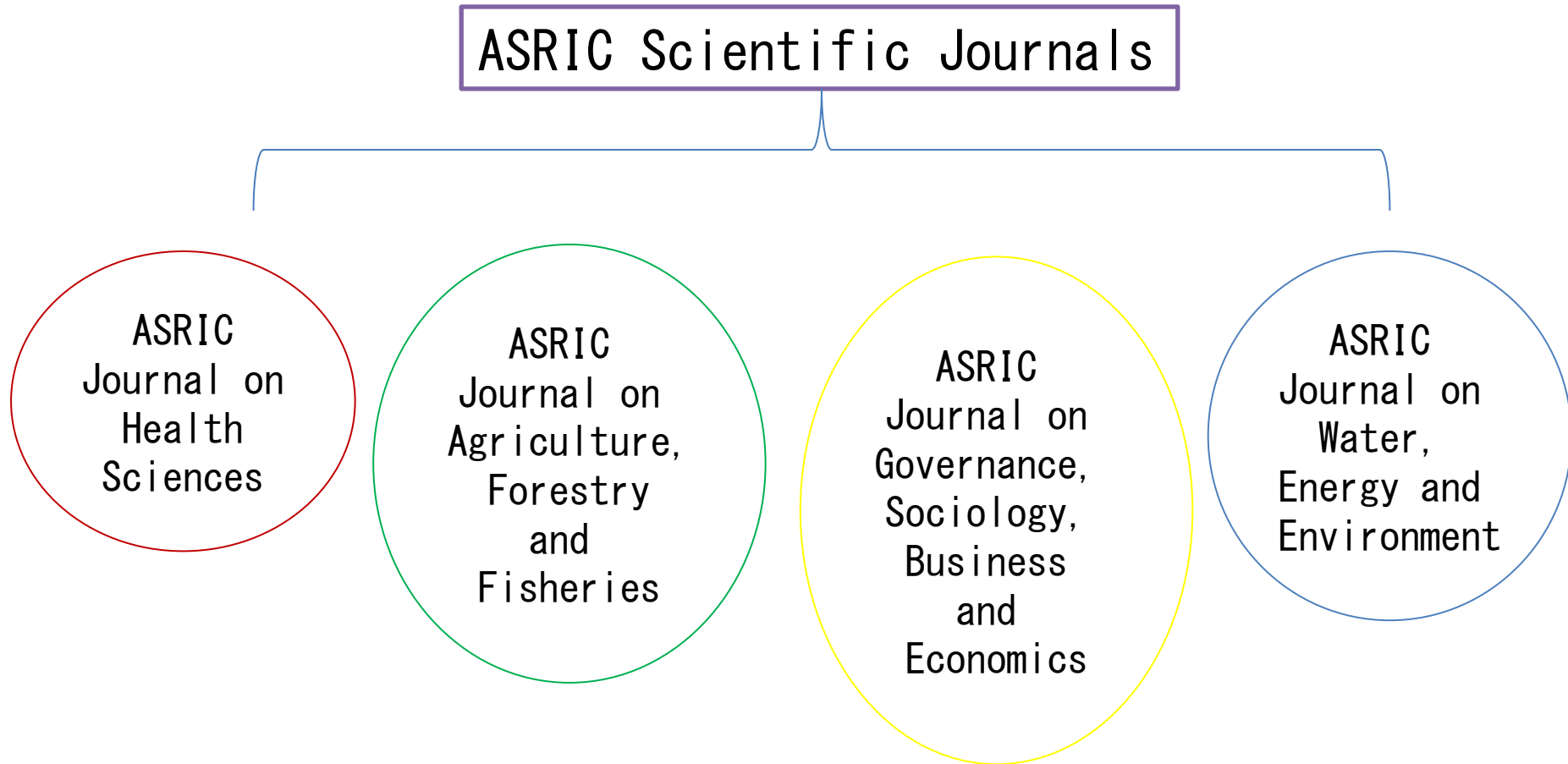
Status of the ASRIC Scientific Journals
